Turn left on to Boren
Turn left on to Pike
Church is on the corner of Pike and Bellevue
400 East Pike St.

Going North on I-5:

Take the Olive Street exit (#166)
Turn right on Bellevue
Church is on the corner of Pike and Bellevue
400 East Pike St.
